
My Orders - Default Date Range Expanded to 4 Months

When accessing My Orders you will now see the last 4 months of orders presented in the listing by default. Previously, this was 3 months.

My Orders - View Customer PO Number


To view the customer PO number for your order, click on **View Customer PO** under **Options** when viewing the order details.



My Orders - Orders Export Feature

Need to send shipment status information to your customer for multiple sales orders across a job, PO, or ship to? Use the filter by options to return the sales orders you are looking for. Click the Export Results button to export the sales orders that were returned to an Excel file.

In the example below we used the Job Name filter to find orders related to a single job. There are 4 sales order (delivery groups) returned. Clicking on the **Export Results** button will export the shipping details for these orders to an Excel file shown below.
