SUBJECT: Louver Blade Reinforcing Angle Location Change



Upon the release of CAPS® 4.28 in December 2018 the following louver models will feature a design change that reduces the frequency of our rear hidden vertical blade support angle from 48 inches on center to 60 inches on center. This change helps relieve manufacturing capacity issues and should help contribute to improve lead times.

Louver section widths ranging from greater than 48 in. - 60 in. and greater than 96 in. - 120 in. will be affected by this design change. This change will have no impact to the products' standard catalogued 25 PSF wind load capacity.

Any orders processed upon the release of CAPS 4.28 will be manufactured incorporating this design change. We can still accommodate 48 inch on center blade support angles via a standard design request (SDR), but please be advised production delays may be a result.
